Tuition is given by a genuine French lecturer

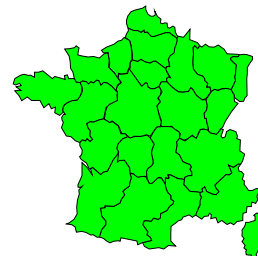
Duration – 22 hours. 11 sessions including one for final revision/test

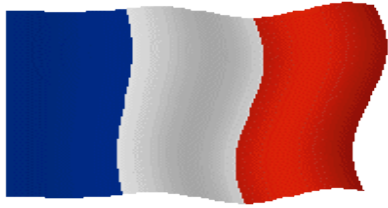
Course Outline - As this is an basic level, considerable emphasis will be placed on the following contents:

- ⇒ Pronunciation of Alphabets and Vowels
- ⇒ French phonetics
- ⇒ Sentence constructions
- ⇒ Everyday useful phrases
- ⇒ Formation of Masculine, Feminine and Plural
- ⇒ Verbs: Introduction of Present tense Conjugation
- ⇒ Basic comprehension skills (through passage reading, dialogue and questions)
- ⇒ A new set of vocabulary to be taught each session
- ⇒ Introduction to French civilization & culture, country, famous artists
- ⇒ Each session to include audio/video to develop listening techniques
- ⇒ Discovery of traditional French songs (maybe choir)

The following are selected topics, which will be focused according to the progress:

- ⇒ Introduction / presentation of oneself - Profession, Nationality....
- ⇒ Numbers, Prices
- ⇒ Day / Month / Year / Time
- ⇒ The weather/seasons
- ⇒ Family Members, friends - Descriptions

Duration – 22 hours. 11 sessions including one for final revision/test

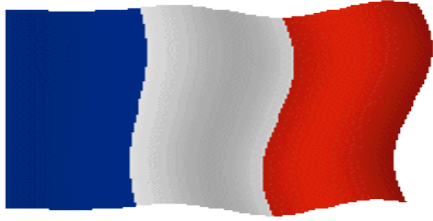
Course Outline - As this is an intermediate level, considerable emphasis will be placed on the following contents:

- ⇒ Each session to include (time permitting) audio / French movies DVD to develop listening techniques
