BAHASA MELAYU

The Malay language, also known locally as *Bahasa Melayu*, is an Austronesian language spoken by the Malay people who reside in the Malay peninsula, southern Thailand, Philippines, Singapore, central eastern Sumatra, the Riau islands, and parts of the coast of Borneo. It is an official language of Malaysia, Brunei and Singapore and also used as a working language in East Timor. It is very similar to (and mutually intelligible with) Bahasa Indonesia, the official language of Indonesia, but differentiated in name for political reasons. The official standard for Malay, as agreed upon by Indonesia, Malaysia and Brunei, is Bahasa Baku, the language of the Riau Islands, long considered the birthplace of the Malay language

BASIC LEVEL

This is especially suitable for people who have no knowledge of Malay. The learner, upon finishing the course, would have adequate basic foundation to listen and understand simple dialogue or conversation on some topics. It is a good module to provide the students with simple phrases needed to make their vacation to Malay-Speaking countries more enjoyable.

Course Content Includes: → Malay Phonetics (Vowels, Pronunciations etc).
→ Basic Greetings
→ Basic Vocabulary, Grammar & Sentence Structures.
→ Common terms & sentences usage (Greetings, Shopping etc).
→ Conversational interactions

INTERMEDIATE LEVEL

The objective of these sessions is to strengthen the student's knowledge in listening, reading & speaking Malay. The learner, with the lecturer's assistance, will be able to understand and reply to simple dialogue or conversation at the completion of the course. This is most suitable for students interested in more in-depth conversation using the language.

Course Content Includes: → More complex sentence structures
→ Wider coverage of vocabulary & grammar.
→ In depth conversational interactions & practices.
→ Using audio-visual to aid intonation and pronunciation.

ADVANCE LEVEL

This class is suitable for people with an intermediate knowledge of the language and an interest in its culture. Using cultural stories and audio/visual aid to stimulate the students to further development in the language, the learner, with the lecturer's assistance, would have a strong foundation to understand dialogue and conversation on a variety of topics.
